Introduction

Expectations

In this class, you are expected to come in and get to work. Class time is extremely valuable, as most of the assignments you will be working on are best to be completed in the studio. Work to be done outside of class is permissible, as long as it is completed by the deadline. Several absences will affect your grade, as the quality of your work is dependent on the time spent working in class. Extensions can be accommodated if you communicate with me **before** the due date/time. If all of your work and assignments are done for my class first, you may work on assignments for other classes, or complete additional sketchbook assignments. In this class we treat ourselves, peers, and teachers with the utmost respect. Disrespect will not be tolerated. Use kind words and uplift others.

Grading

There will be no extra credit in this class, your grade will be fine if you complete your assignments to the best of your ability and by the due date. Don't skip out on the

small assignments (sketchbook, ideation, reflection etc.), these points add up and will affect your final grade. Each major assignment will be valued differently. This is dependent upon work time, technicality, skills used, and difficulty of the use of materials. The time and effort you put into your art will be reflected in your grade. If more than 5 classes are missed, we will have a discussion about how this is affecting your grade. Aesthetics do not matter in this class, but rather the ability to think outside the box and try new things. There will be no homework, unless you need extra time to work on an assignment.

In Class
